

Voice and Vote Count in Prince George's County



1) On the fence? This is the most important election of our lifetimes! For real.

Your vote is your voice. It matters. Please vote.



2) Register. Make sure you're registered. Go to https://voterservices.elections.maryland.gov/VoterSearch to find out if you're registered or to register today. If it's after Oct. 13, you can register in-person during early voting (held Oct. 26-Nov. 2) or on Election Day (Nov. 3) with a Maryland ID.





3) Worried about COVID? You're not alone. The good news? There are many ways to vote in the County. You can request a mail-in ballot, vote in-person early or vote in-person on Election Day.

We'll explore each option.

4) Want to vote by mail? You must request your ballot—and do it quickly! All requests must be received by Oct. 20. Make your request now at https://elections.maryland.gov/voting/absentee.html





6) Want to vote in-person early? Cool! Grab a mask and vote early to show off that sticker. Vote early Mon. Oct. 26 to Mon. Nov. 2 from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. at:

5) Already requested a mail-in ballot? It may take a couple weeks to arrive. When it does, use black ink to carefully fill in the ovals for your candidates. Don't vote for more than the number specified, but you can vote for fewer! Use the envelope provided, sign the oath on the back and bring it to an official ballot drop box (at all locations in #7) or the Board of Elections office, 1100 Mercantile Lane, Suite 115A, Largo. Or drop it in the mail—no stamp needed. No matter what, return it early!



7) Want to vote safely on Election Day? Great! Grab a mask, put on comfy shoes—lines could be long—and vote in-person on Tuesday, Nov. 3 from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. at any of these locations:
